

FORD MAINTENANCE PROTECTION PLAN

ENJOY THE DRIVE EVEN MORE WITH PREPAID MAINTENANCE

REGULAR MAINTENANCE OF YOUR VEHICLE WILL HELP ENSURE OPTIMUM PERFORMANCE YEAR AFTER YEAR

- Scheduled Maintenance – FMPP covers all required scheduled maintenance items, as shown at right.
- \$0 Deductible.
- 8 Wear Items – The following are covered, if required, due to failure caused by normal wear:
 - Brake pads and linings
 - Brake rotors
 - Clutch disc
 - Engine belts and hoses
 - Light bulbs (excluding headlamps)
 - Shock absorbers
 - Spark plugs
 - Wiper blades
- Extended Component Coverage – 3 year/75,000 km, 4 year/80,000 km, 4 year/100,000 km, and 5 year/100,000 km FMPP Plus! Plans include PremiumCARE component coverage after the expiration of the New Vehicle Basic Warranty.†
- Rental Car Option – A first-day rental car option is available at extra cost for rental assistance when your vehicle is left for maintenance and repairs covered by the Basic Coverage under the New Vehicle Limited Warranty or Ford ESP. It starts the first day and reimburses up to \$35/day for up to 2 days.
- 2,000 Kilometre Window – Maintenance may be performed any time within 1,000 km before or after the scheduled interval. However, Ford recommends that all maintenance services be performed at the time/distance intervals specified in your vehicle's Customer Information Guide (also known as the Owner Information Guide).
- Backed By Ford – FMPP is backed by Ford Motor Company of Canada, Limited and honoured at more than 4,500 authorized Ford, Ford Lincoln and Mercury Dealers in Canada and the United States.
- Transferable – If you sell the vehicle, remaining coverage may be transferred to the new owner. It can add to the retail value of your vehicle!
- Financing – May be included in your finance contract in most cases.

† Time and distance limitations for Ford FMPP/ESP New Vehicle Plans are calculated from the time the vehicle is initially put into service and zero kilometres. Ford FMPP/ESP New Vehicle Plans are effective concurrently with the New Vehicle Basic Warranty and are not extensions of the New Vehicle Basic Warranty. See your Dealer for details.

FORD MAINTENANCE PROTECTION PLAN (SAMPLE MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE)

MAINTENANCE SERVICE #1

- Change engine oil
- Replace oil filter
- Multi-point inspection

MAINTENANCE SERVICE #2

- Change engine oil
- Replace oil filter
- Multi-point inspection
- Inspect tires for wear and rotate

MAINTENANCE SERVICE #3

- Change engine oil
- Replace oil filter
- Multi-point inspection
- Inspect tires for wear and rotate
- Replace cabin/pollen air filter (if equipped)
- Inspect brake pads, shoes, rotors, drums, brake lines and hoses and parking brake system
- Lubricate hinges, latches, locks, sliding door tracks and weather stripping
- Clean battery terminals
- Replace "green" engine coolant every 36 months or 60,000 km (whichever comes first)
- Check and lubricate steering, suspension, ball joints, drive shaft U-joints and slip yoke (if serviceable)
- Inspect engine coolant system and hoses (check coolant strength and secure clamps)
- Inspect wheels for end play or noise

MAINTENANCE SERVICE #4

- Change engine oil
- Replace oil filter
- Multi-point inspection
- Inspect tires for wear and rotate
- Replace engine air and engine crank case filter
- Replace fuel filter
- Replace manual transmission fluid every 60 months or 100,000 km (light trucks, SUVs and Lincoln LS)
- Automatic transmission/transaxle service
- Replace climate-controlled seat filters at 100,000 km
- Replace "yellow" engine coolant at 60 months or 100,000 km (whichever comes first)

YOUR DRIVING HABITS WILL DETERMINE THE OPTIMUM MAINTENANCE INTERVAL FOR YOUR VEHICLE. PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES:

Follow a 6 month/10,000 km maintenance interval for 2007 and prior model year vehicles, or a 6 month/12,000 km maintenance interval for 2008 and beyond model year vehicles, if **none** of these conditions apply:

- You tow a trailer or use a camper or car-top carrier.
- Most trips include extensive idling (such as frequent driving in stop and go traffic).
- Carrying heavy loads.
- The vehicle is used for delivery service, police, taxi or other commercial application.
- You operate in dusty conditions such as unpaved or dusty roads.
- You operate off-road.

Follow a 3 month/5,000 km (for 2007 and prior model year vehicles) or a 6 month/8,000 km (for 2008 and beyond model year vehicles) maintenance interval if any of the above conditions apply.
